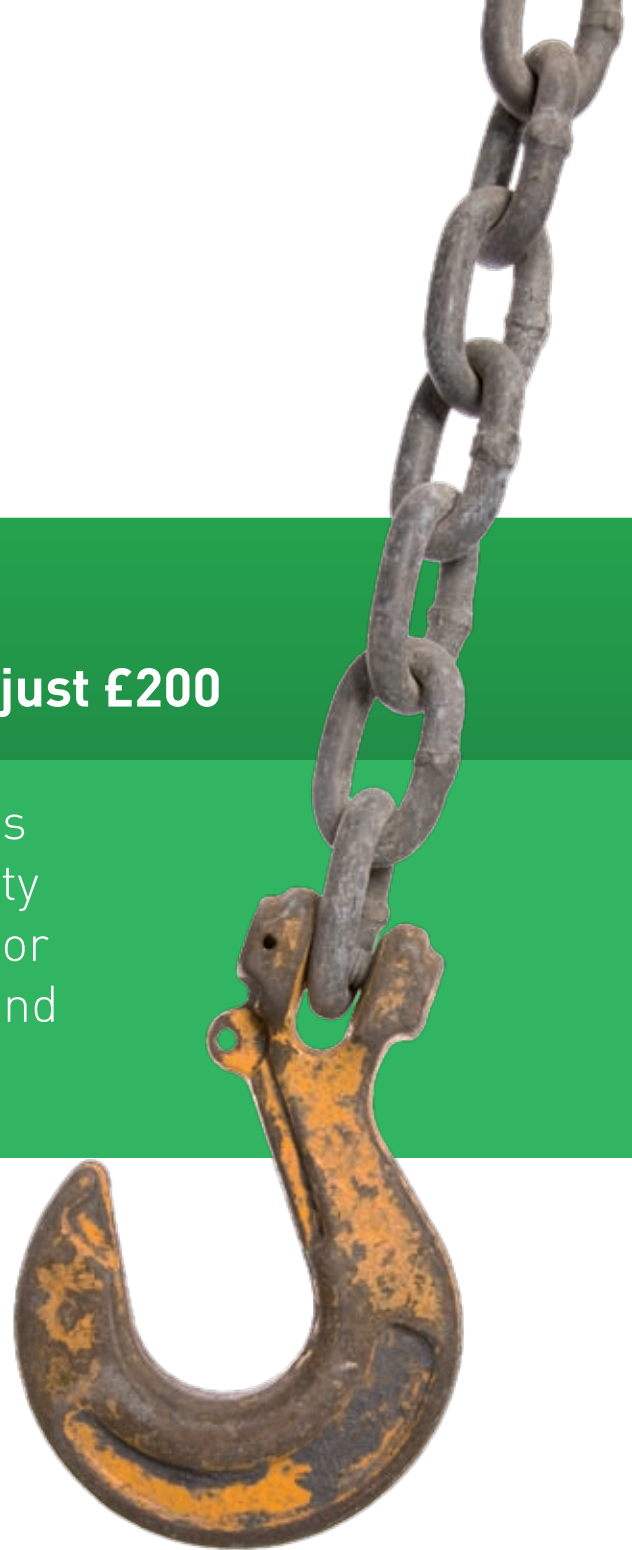

Green Compass is a scheme that gives anyone disposing of waste the certainty it will be collected, checked, recycled or disposed of in an environmentally sound fashion.

The scheme aims to develop a network of UKAS accredited waste management companies that are compliant with the new PAS 402:2009 (Publicly Available Specification) and is available to all waste resource management organizations in the United Kingdom and Ireland.

In Wales we'd like to offer you the chance of getting the new PAS 402:2009, and accessing over £5000 worth of funding for just £200. This funding is available for a limited time, and we urge you to participate now, in fact, it is intended that public sector procurement strategies will expect tendering companies to achieve this- can you afford to miss out?

Constructing Excellence in Wales(CEW) has developed PAS 402:2009 which requires waste resource management organisations that process construction and demolition, industrial, commercial or household waste, to produce a report that details how they conduct specific waste management activities and the landfill diversion and material recovery rates they achieve.



Benefits from the Green Compass Scheme include:

- An increase in the reuse and recycling of construction and demolition waste in Wales
- Improved efficiency across business performance
- Provision of independently verified and validated performance data for clients and government including landfill diversion and materials recovery rates
- Increased landfill diversion rates and recovery opportunities for waste management organisations
- Increased customer confidence
- A framework to enable waste management businesses to continuously improve their waste management practices whilst increasing levels of awareness of waste management best practises
- Development of procurement strategies with industry and public sector to direct waste to Green Compass waste management organisations
