





Common Challenges

- Design Still not influencing design early enough
- Supply Chain Importance of site waste and information
- Timescales Programmes often limit opportunities for making waste a priority
- Composite materials
- Time and resource pressures
- Improvement in waste management and landfill diversion, but need to focus more on waste prevention
- Communication an issue for all projects






