CE Marking in Steel

On the 1st July 2014 the CE Marking of fabricated steelwork will become mandatory in the UK for all manufacturers involved in structural steelwork, after which date it will be illegal to trade fabricated steelwork and related products on the European market unless it has CE accreditation.

The Welsh Government Construction Sector, in conjunction with Construction Industry Training Board (CITB) construction skills, Engineering Construction Industry Training Board (ECITB), British Constructional Steelwork Association (BCSA) and the Welsh Government Innovation team, invites you to a series of morning events aimed at preparing businesses for the mandatory July 2014 EU legislation concerning CE marking of fabricated steelwork.

The event will provide an invaluable platform for businesses to learn about their obligations in this area, the support available to them, and will also provide an opportunity to network and hear from leading industry speakers.
