Excellence by Example

Constructing Excellence in Wales is the united voice of the construction sector in Wales, and a platform from which to stimulate, debate and drive much needed change in the sector. Since Welsh Government relinquished their funding, we now rely on membership fees to continue the CE movement in Wales.

The CEWales Member MoU is a more formal membership process. It is an acknowledgement that a member of CEWales will have successfully demonstrated that they have met and are operating to, the underlying principles and values of Constructing Excellence in Wales, fully in line with the commitments of the Future Generations Act.

Members need to commit to:

- Driving a shared vision that industry improvement, change and successful project delivery will be achieved through collaboration and innovation
- Sharing of knowledge and best practice, within the sector and more broadly
- Creation of an inclusive workplace where people are supported to be their best
- Improving opportunities and quality of life in the communities in which they work including maximising job, training and apprenticeship opportunities
- Working in partnership to deliver a built environment for Wales that is demonstrably better, sustainable and low carbon, which meets present day requirements without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their needs
- Driving up sector standards, particularly as they relate to quality, health, safety and the environment
- Actively engaging with customers, stakeholders and partners in delivering for communities – focussing on outcomes and end user experience
- Being fair and accessible, and promoting choice
- Continuously developing and improving

Members will be held to account against these criteria; we encourage all members to promote these commitments and values and use the CEWales logo on letterheads, email signatures and tender documents, to demonstrate to others the commitment and gain external credit. It is requested that members provide a testimonial and case studies that will be published on the CEWales website as a recognition of a commitment to the standards that CEWales seeks to develop and embed within the construction sector in Wales.
