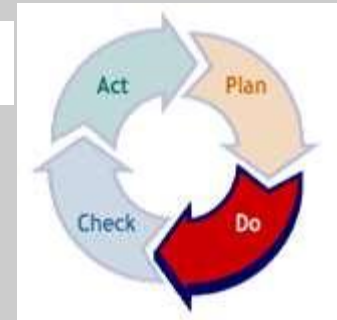

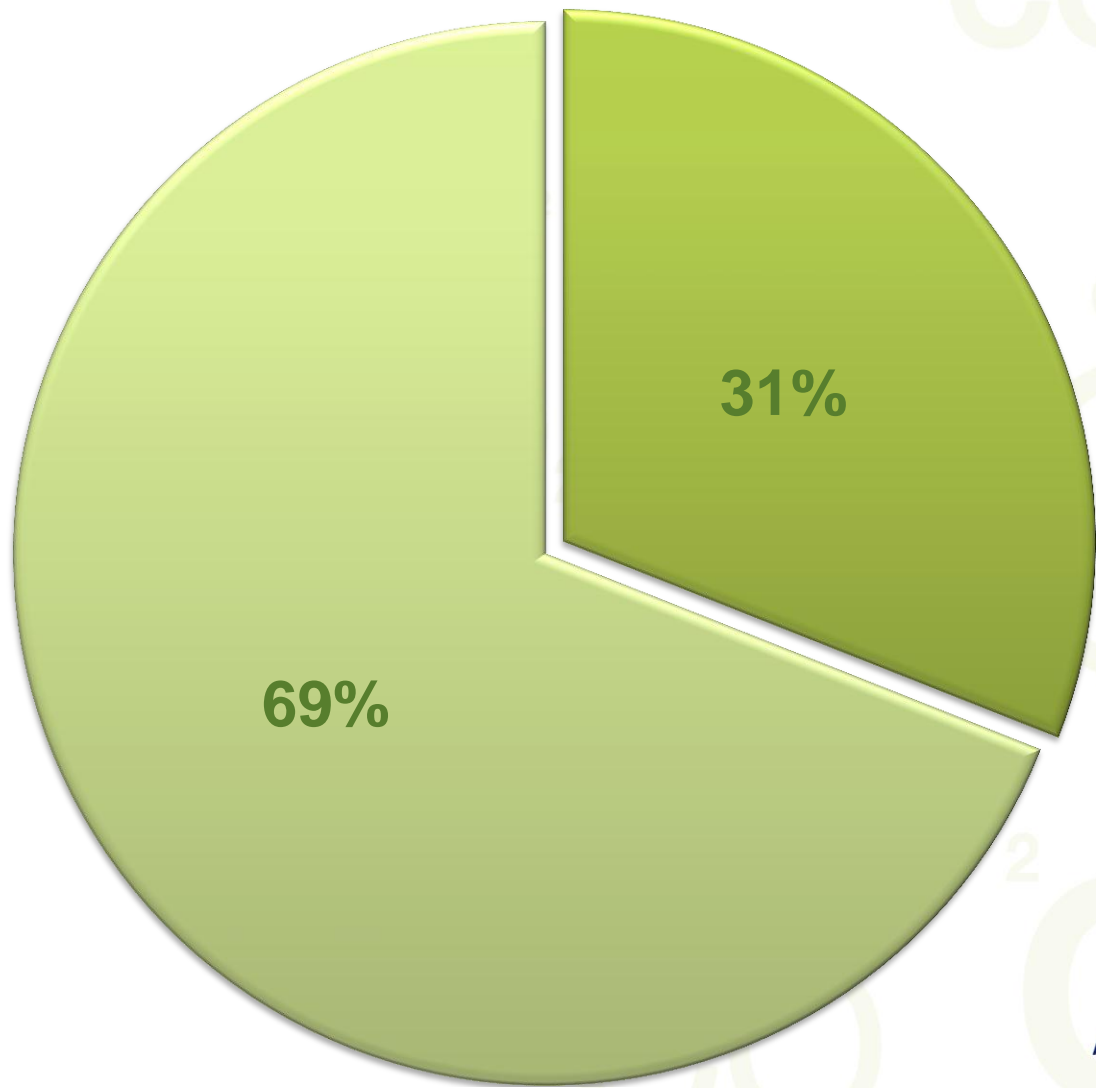

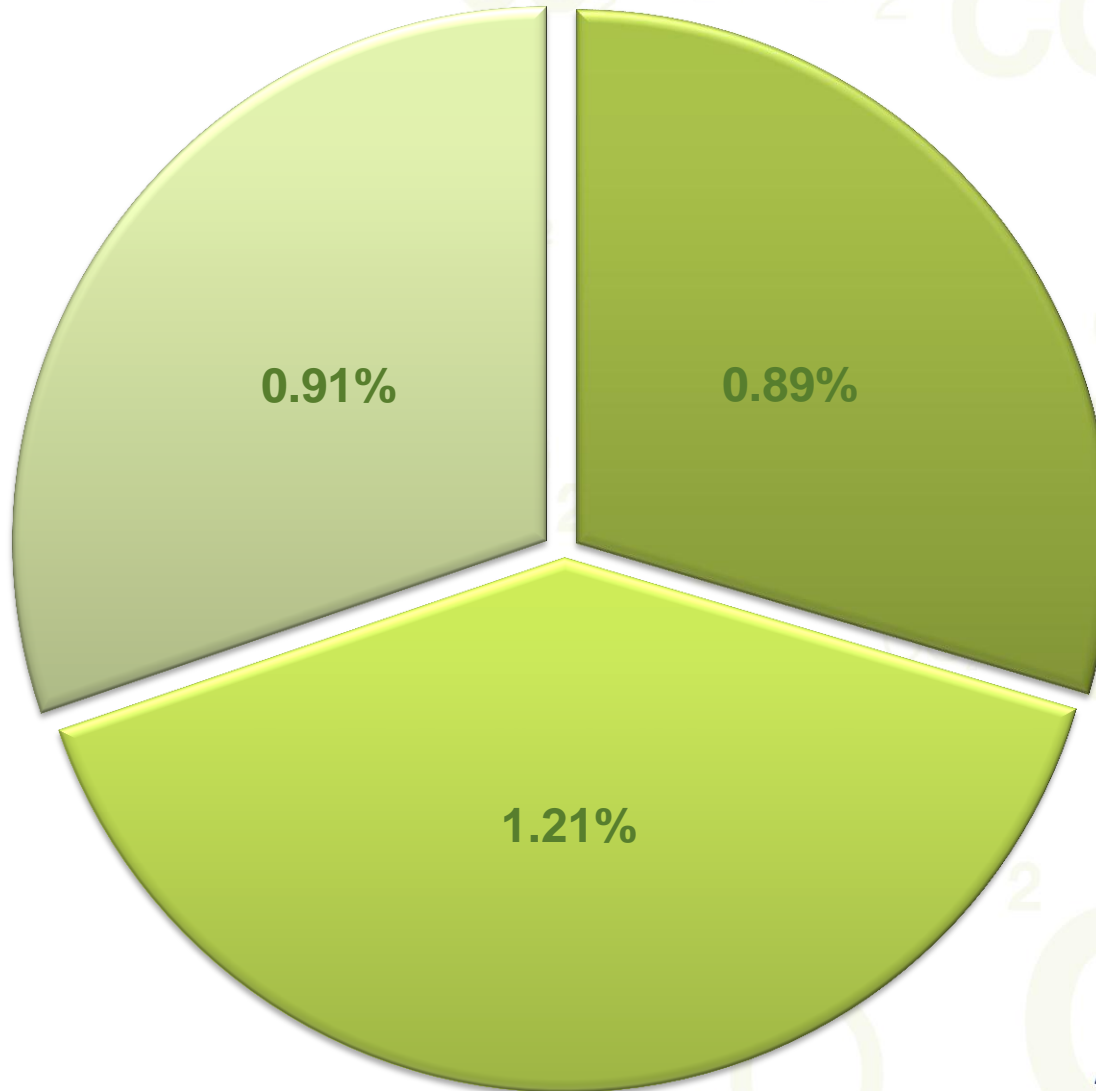

- 3% Target

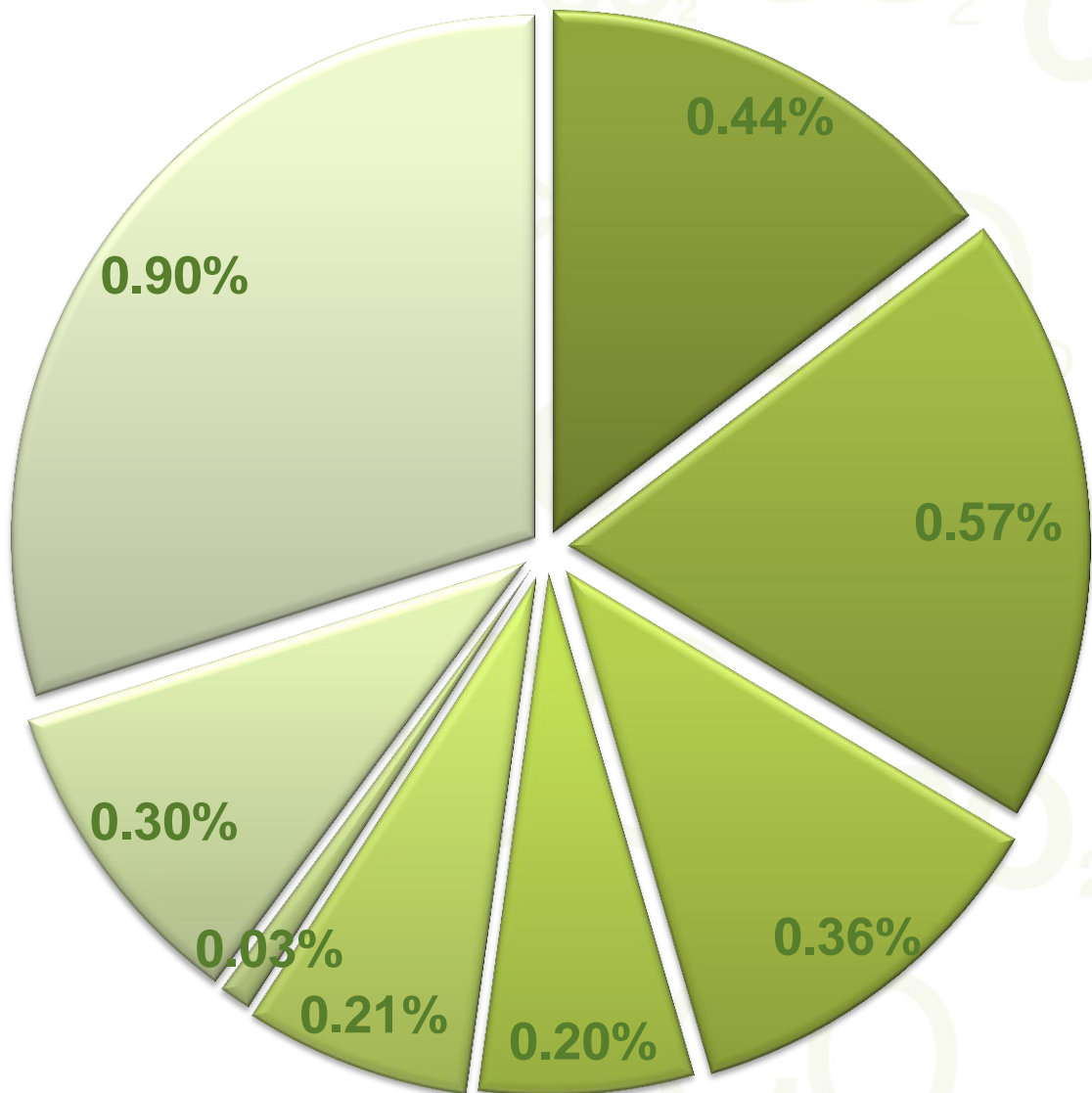
Contribution to the 3% Target (expressed as percentage points)
